Inspired by the Maglieri Family's Italian origins and passion for the Mediterranean lifestyle, Bellissimo is a beautiful collection of wines featuring varieties new to Australia. Crafted in modern, innovative styles, both perfect to enjoy with food, family and friends.

Winemaker Notes

Primitivo is best when the berry size is moderate and uniform - this achieves the best fruit characters. Primitivo vineyard in Clare achieves rich and fragrant fruit. Fermentation temperatures were cool, allowing time for moderate extraction from the skins resulted from daily pump over. The wine finished fermentation in stainless steel and was then transferred to new and two year old oak casks.

Region:	Clare Valley, South Australia
Grape Variety:	Primitivo (This varietal clone has origins back to Italy)
Colour:	The Primitivo is bright crimson red with a brilliant purple hue
Bouquet:	Lifted aromas of cherries combined with mulberry, blueberry, licorice and oak
Palate:	Primitivo is an exciting wine with flavours of blackberries; spice and licorice complemented by cedary oak notes and long balanced tannins.
Vineyard:	The fruit for this wine is sourced from estate vineyards in the in the Fleurieu Peninsula region, Whites Valley
Cellaring:	Enjoy now, while it's young or cellar for five years
Food Match:	Due to the wines robust nature, we recommend all cuts of barbecued meats and Mediterranean cuisine
Alcohol:	14%
