Serafino Cabernet Sauvignon 2015

When I think Serafino, I think Italian varieties, so it's nice to get surprised by a wine from a McLaren Vale staple. Serious feeling and looking bottle for a sub-\$30 wine too. Quite a bit of unexpected restraint too.

Neat medium weight feel with good, deep, lavish concentrated fruit. Black plum and berry, cassis, touch of florals, sniff of cedar and sweet tobacco. Good bouquet. Soft texture, sweet fruit, mint highlights, sweet oak spice melted in. It's a warming ooze of dark cabernet. Lots to like here for the generous representation of cabernet.
