

Rich pickings dip into some super Shiraz Serafino Terremoto Shiraz 2010

Terremoto is Italian for earthquake – perhaps this will shake you up a bit. It's certainly a damn fine wine. Deep, dark color and a nose of cloves, spices, licorice and a touch of mocha and chocolate. The palate is velvety, with seamless oak and tannin integration to the generously proportioned fruit.
