Serafino Black Label Story

Serafino Black Label wines are selected from our premium estate vineyard's in McLaren Vale. McLaren Vale has a diverse mix of soil types and vineyard orientation that enhance the complexity of Serafino wines. Distinctive varietal and regional characters are captured in all the premium Black Label wines and consistently over deliver for medium and long term cellaring.

Winemaker Notes

The fruit was destemmed and not crushed in order to preserve freshness of character, and then fermented in four tonne stainless steel open fermenters. Primary fermentation was maintained at cool temperatures for a period of seven days. Upon completion, the fruit was gently pressed to a stainless steel tank allowing for malolactic fermentation to be carried out. Post secondary fermentation the wine was racked to a combination of French and American oak hogsheads (300L) to mature for a twelve month period.
